

ISSUES

- 1. WITH METRO WORK HAPPENING ON ENTIRE ORR STRETCH OF 19 KMS, 03 OUT OF 06 LANES NOT AVAILABLE FOR TRAFFIC
- 2. DUE TO METRO BARRICADING AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS, BOTTLE NECKS CREATED
- 3. VOLUME OF TRAFFIC BEING VERY HIGH, A STUDY SHOWS (29.09.2022, BETWEEN 09 TO 10 AM) VOLUME OF TRAFFIC IS **18721** UNITS IN EXISTING CARRIAGE WAY (FROM HSR TO TIN FACTORY K R PURA IS **9189** UNITS & FROM TIN FACTORY K R PURA TO HSR **9532** UNITS) AS AGAINST IRC STANDARDS OF **5400** UNITS PER HOUR IN 6 LANES
- 4. SHORTAGE OF TRAFFIC STAFF
- 5. SERVICE ROAD IS CLOSED AT CERTAIN STRETCHES FOR METRO CABELING AND OTHER CIVIC WORKS AND SERVICE ROAD ASPALTING IS VERY POOR
- 6. WATER LOGGING & POT HOLES

- 7. NON AVAILABILITY OF BUS BAYS
- 8. BUS SHELTERS ON MAIN CARRIAGE WAY SLOWING DOWN TRAFFIC FLOW
- 9. NON AVAILABLITY OF SPECIFIED PARKING PLACES AND NON AVAILABILITY OF TOWING
- 10. PEDESTRIAN CROSSING AT JUNCTIONS SLOWS DOWN TRAFFIC, NON AVAILABILITY OF SKY WALKS/FOB/SUB WAYS
- 11. SLOW DOWN OF TRAFFIC DUE TO ENTRY AND EXIT OF TRAFFIC FROM ARTIERIAL/SERVICE ROADS TO MAIN CARRIAGE WAY
- 12. NO ALTERNATE ROADS FOR HGVs and BUSES
- 13. INDISCIPLINED ROAD USERS

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

- 1. INCREASED FOCUS ON TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ON OUTER RING ROAD WITH INCREASED DEPLOYMENT OF OFFICERS & STAFF (FROM 6 AM TO 10 PM DEPLOYING 23 PSI/ASI, 110 HC/PCs, 55 HOME GUARDS & 25 MARSHALS)
- 2. IMPROVED ENFORCEMENT OF NO PARKING, AGAINST ONE WAY, RIDING ON FOOTPATH AND OTHER VIOLATIONS
- 3. REMOVAL OF FOOTPATH ENCROACHMENTS
- 4. AWARENESS PROGRAMME FOR ROAD USERS
- 5. STRICT ENFORCEMENT AGAINST HGVs DURING PEAK HOURS 1050 CASES BOOKED THIS YEAR

- 6. WITH INTER DEPARTMENT CO-ORDINATION FILLING OF POT HOLES, JUNCTION IMPROVEMENTS, SHIFTING OF BUS SHELTERS, <u>ROAD WIDENING</u>, SIGN BOARDS AND ROAD MARKINGS
- 7. APP BASED TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AND USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA
- 8. DEPLOYMENT OF TRAFFIC WARDENS, HOME GAURDS AND MARSHALS FROM ORR
- 9. INCREASED BIKE PATROLING ON ORR
