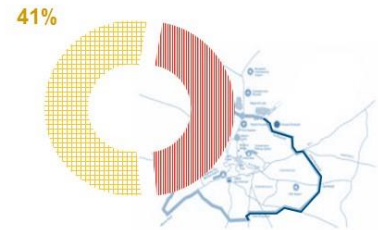

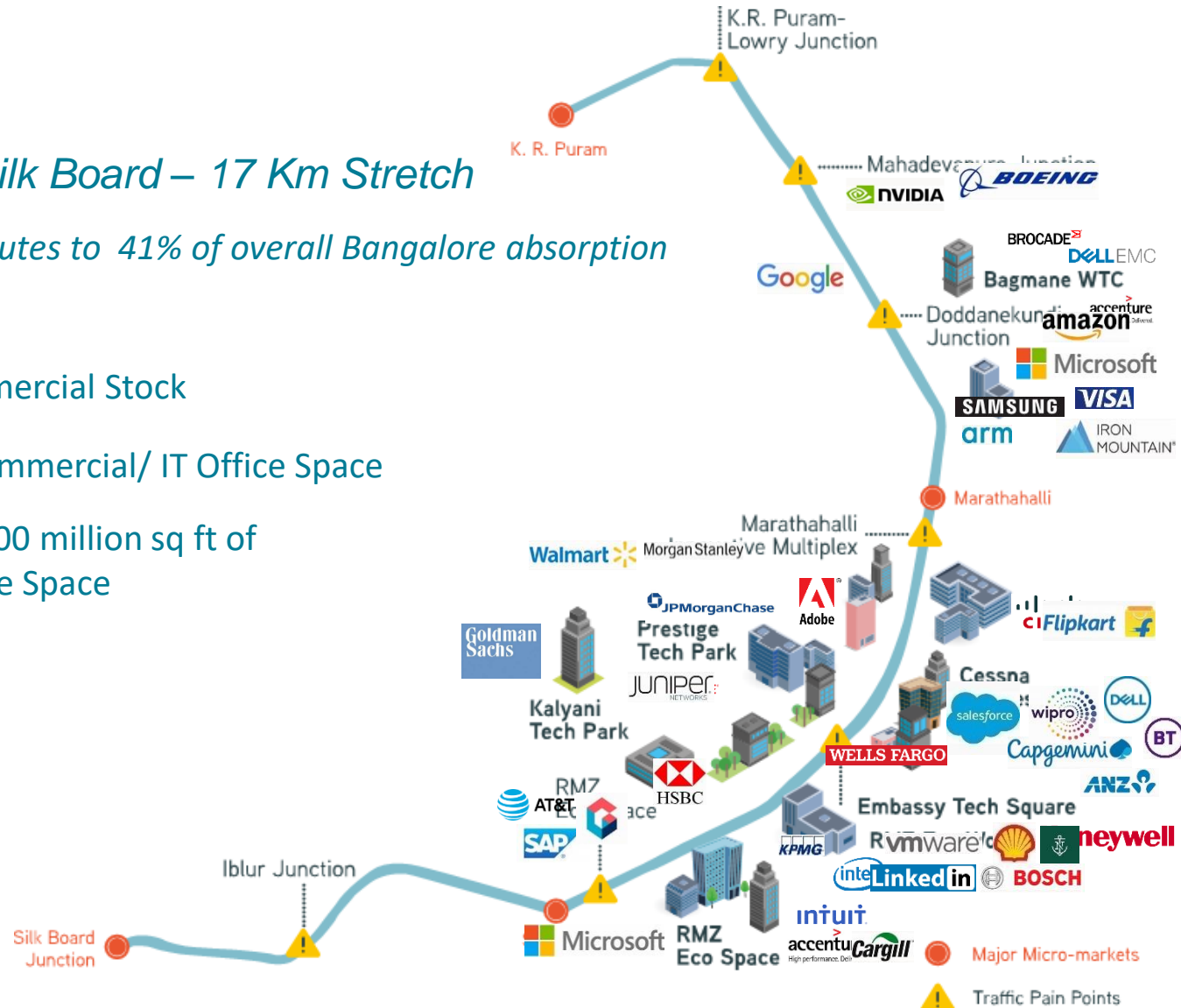

Outer Ring Road contributes to 41% of overall Bangalore absorption

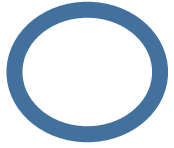
Outer Ring Road – Commercial Stock

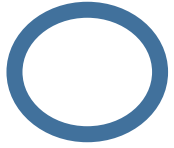
